Tournament Rules Set by State Bowling Rules Committee:

- 1. Teams shall consist of 5 persons. Participants shall be members of the Elks, in good standing, or their spouse with current identification card.
- 2. Tournament events shall be doubles and singles. If a bowler bowls singles, he/she must bowl in doubles or vice-versa.
- 3. Bowlers may enter twice in team event if enough shifts are available. Bowlers may bowl in doubles twice if needed for an emergency substitute, but will not be permitted to bowl singles twice.
- 4. Handicap is 90% of 220 scratch average with pin limit per game.
- 5. Any bowler who reports a lower average than required shall forfeit all tournament entry fees and winnings.
- 6. Averages will be taken from the past <u>five</u> years' average from the Ky State Bowling Tournament, <u>unless</u> bowlers last year's highest yearbook average of their home bowling league <u>is 15 Pin Higher</u>. If no Tournament or book average, then the bowler will use their current highest average from 21 games bowled in any sanctioned league prior to the Elks State Tournament. If no average, men will use 170 averages per game and women will use 150 averages per game.
 - Furthermore, the Tournament Director will maintain a list of averages from the past <u>five</u> years' events.
- 7. Prize ratio shall be one place for each 6 entries in Team Event. Prize ratio for Singles and Doubles should be one for each 5 entries. If an All Events category is conducted during the State Tournament, the ratio of prize fund should be one for each 10 entries. Prize fees will be returned 100% less First Place Trophy for all Events Champion.
- 8. Entry Fee: Set by the host lodge, with \$10.00 for prize fund and \$2.00 for tournament expenses, Line fees negotiated with the bowling center. If the host lodge desires to hold an optional All Events category, the additional fee of \$5.00 per bowler desiring to participate will be collected.
- 9. In case of a malfunction in the automatic scoring device and scores are irretrievable for the frames bowled, they will be re-bowled when the malfunction is corrected, or bowlers will be moved to another pair of lanes as soon as they are available (no practice will be permitted).
- 10. In case of emergency and a bowler can't bowl a blind score may be used, Tournament Average less 10 Pins.
- 11. In case of a late arrival a bowler will receive a zero for any frame missed or can wait for the next game to start.

Meeting for these rules were adopted during the 2019 KY State Elks Bowling Committee Meeting in Frankfort June 23.
